2024 FRIENDS FOR FUN MIXER TOURNAMENTS – GUIDELINES

PARTICIPATION: All bowlers (youth and adult) must have a current TNBA card. At least one team member must have three+ years of holding a TNBA membership card. No temporary membership accepted and no cards can be purchased at the tournament site.

EVENTS: This tournament will consist of three different mixer events.

CENTURY DOUBLES MIXER

Combined ages = 100+
1st Place - \$3000

OPEN DOUBLES MIXER

Teams may be any mix
1st Place - \$5000

ADULT / YOUTH MIXER

Youth ages 12-18 and adult
Scholarships & Prizes

ENTRY FEES AND REFUNDS: Entry - \$150 per event. No refunds and no exceptions.

PRIZE LIST: The prize fund will be paid at 100% for the Century Doubles and Open Doubles Events at a ratio of at least 1:10. Scholarships and premium prizes may be awarded for the Adult/Youth Mixer Event. Multiple criteria for scholarships may include: advanced bowling accomplishments, scholastic achievements, community involvement, tournaments scores from January 14, 2024, and/or other measures as determined by the tournament committee (see scholarship application for details). Both adults and youth will be eligible to win premium prizes which may include: bowling balls, autographed memorabilia, tournament entry vouchers, travel vouchers, and more. Youth bowlers must establish a smart account prior to receiving a scholarship (or have an existing smart account.) - *no* exceptions. Maximum one scholarship permitted annually.

FORMAT: Each event will comprise six games: Three Scotch Doubles, and Three Baker's Doubles.

AVERAGE AND HANDICAP: The combined book averages may not exceed 450 per team based on the highest 2022–23 sanctioned winter league averages of 21 or more games in any one league. The team average handicap is 90% of 225.

DEADLINE: Deadline for entry is December 15, 2023. Early bird entries will be eligible for additional drawings and prizes (early bird date - December 1st). No walk-in entries permitted.

SPECTATORS: Events are open to bowling participants and invited guests only. Spectators that wish to attend will be asked to donate \$10 for entry per event (to be paid in advance only) and this amount may be added to the Adult/Youth Event. **All spectator donations must be submitted with bowling fees/form.** **No** walk in spectators permitted. There may be drawings for spectators at each event.

AGE REQUIREMENTS: The combined ages of team members for the Century Doubles must complete at least 100 years as of January 1, 2024. The minimum age for the Open Doubles is 18 as of January 1, 2024. The minimum age for youth is 12 as of January 1, 2024. The maximum age for youth is 18 as of December 31, 2023.

DRAWINGS: Any youth that does not have a partner to bowl with may submit an application (for scholarship, eligibility and prizes) and will be paired with the adult volunteers. Any youth that desires to bowl with a pro/celebrity will be entered in a drawing on January 13, 2024. The 450 team average will be waived if the team average exceeds the requirement due to a drawing.

SUBSTITUTIONS: Substitutions may be permitted, but **must be made** at least one hour prior to the scheduled bowling event time. Contact the tournament manager for all substitutions. No walk-in substitutes will be allowed and no refunds will be given.

PROS: Any person (pro or celebrity) with a TNBA membership card is eligible to bowl in this tournament providing all other criteria is met.

SANCTION: Due to the modified format of these events, this tournament is not sanctioned.

SPONSOR: This event is being sponsored by Friends for Fun, Diana Collins – Tournament Manager, in partnership with TNBA, Mookie Betts, Michael Harris, and Celebrity Friends. The tournament officials will make the final decision when matters/questions arise, and their ruling shall be final.

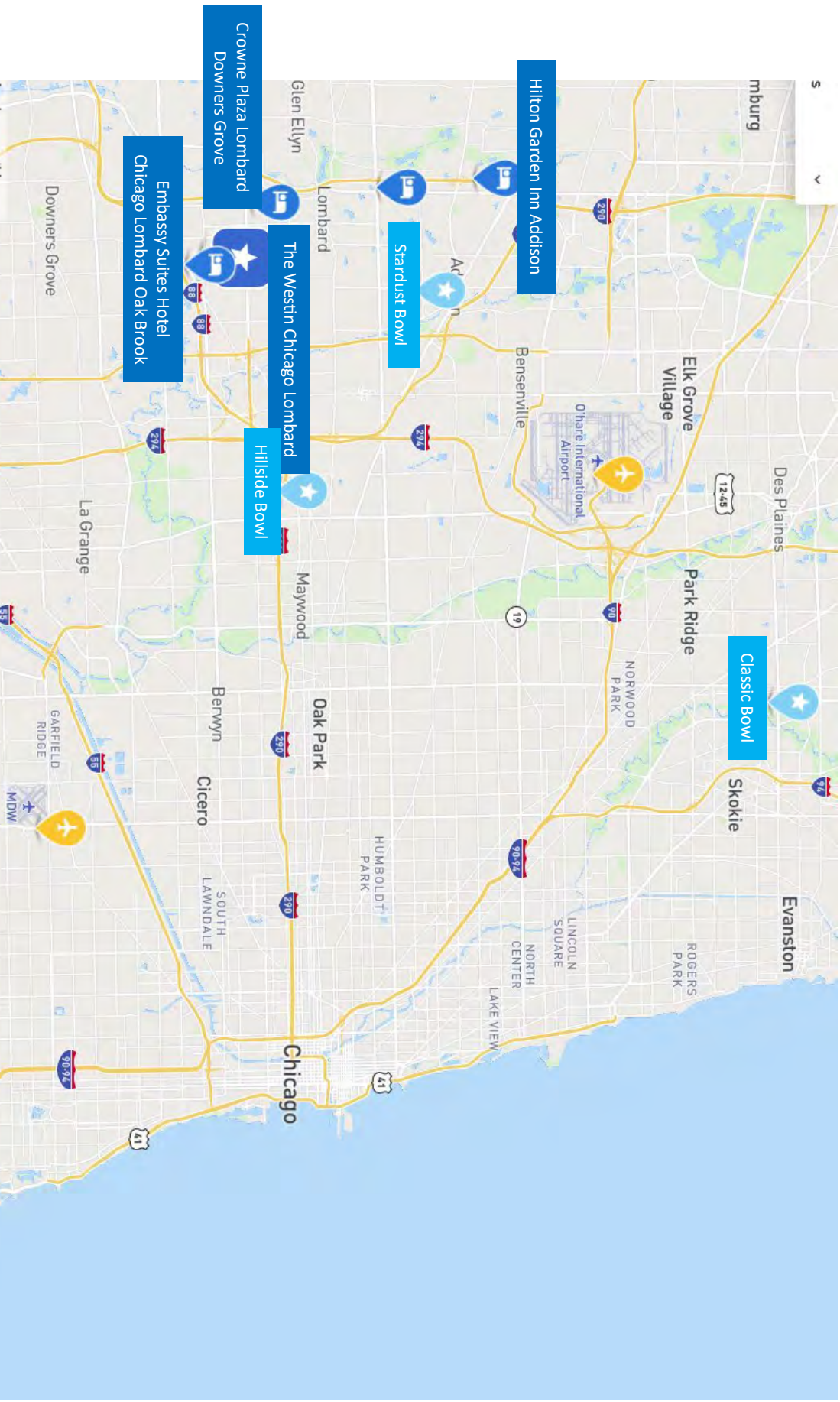

Any bowler not ready to bowl when his or her turn comes shall be given a ZERO (0) for that frame.
14. The tournament director reserves the right to disqualify any bowler not in compliance with the rules of the tournament. The tournament operates under the rules of TNBA and USBC. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency causes relating thereto fire, natural disaster, or any other reason beyond control of the TNBA Western Regional Tournament shall cause, the extent required hereby, all prizes to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
15. Proper attire is required. No head gear (hat, cap, etc.). Tournament Director reserves the right to final decisions on proper attire. **Bowlers in Improper Attire will not be allowed to bowl.** Bowlers may be rescheduled, but NO refund of their entry fee.
16. It shall be the bowlers responsibility to verify the accuracy of his/her TNBA and USBC numbers. Using incorrect TNBA or USBC number may be subject to disqualification.
17. Tardy players will start in the frame being bowled with Zero (0) given for each frame missed. If a team refuses to start because a full line-up is not present, they shall forfeit all games that they decline to bowl. No blind scores shall be permitted. No make-up frames will be allowed.
18. If a breakdown of the lanes occurs that exceeds ten(10) minutes, the tournament committee reserves the right to move bowlers to another pair of lanes to avoid shift delays.
19. Championship will be determined by the greatest total actual pin fall, plus handicap. Prizes will be awarded to handicap division and actual division winners. There will be at least one (1) prize for every 10 entries.
20. **Current or past PBA members will be permitted to bowl in TNBA tournaments** if they have not achieved the following: (a) top 40 on PBA tour money or point list in the past three years; (b) won a PBA tour title in past seven years; (c) top 20 on PBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past four years. **PBA50 and WPBA members will be permitted to bowl** providing they have not achieved the following: (a) top 20 on PBA50/WPBA tour money or point list in the past two years; (b) won a PBA50/WPBA tour title in past four years; (c) top 10 on PBA50/WPBA Regional tour money or point list; (d) won a PBA Regional tour title in past two years. **Only one PBA bowler allowed per team.**
21. Any one working in the host bowling center in which they are employed may not bowl in the event held at that center.

1. ENTRIES CLOSE APRIL 15, 2024. ALL ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETED IN FULL. NO ENTRIES ACCEPTED AT THE TOURNAMENT. FINAL ENTRIES AND RE-ENTRIES WILL CLOSE SUNDAY MAY 26, 2024 AT 1:00 PM. **BOTH PARTICIPANTS MUST BE 55 OR OLDER.**
2. All entrants must have a TNBA and USBC membership card prior to bowling. TNBA membership cards may be purchased at the site at a cost of \$35.00. USBC Membership cards may be purchased at a cost of \$35.00 (USBC Rule 300C). Each membership includes a processing fee.
3. We encourage you to submit your entries online. If mailing entries, the Total Entry Fee must accompany the entry form, and all certified checks and money orders made payable to: The National Bowling Association - Tournament Fund (TNBA - Tournament Fund). DO NOT remit cash. After an entry has been received and dates assigned by tournament management and not refused before preparation of the schedule, the entry fee cannot be refunded (USBC Rule 314). Prize fund checks must be cashed with 90 days of receipt or will be voided.
4. Preferred dates will be granted when possible. When lanes are filled on requested dates, **The next available open date will be given.** Entries will be scheduled on first come, first serve basis.
5. **Averages:**
 - a. Use 2022-2023 highest USBC league average of 21 games or more. No summer or composite averages will be accepted.
 - b. If no 2022-2023 average, use highest 2023-2024 USBC average of 21 games or more at the time of bowling.
 - c. USBC SPORT AND CHALLENGE AVERAGES will be allowed. All averages established on a Sport or Challenge condition must be adjusted utilizing the USBC Sport/Challenge Adjustment scale. The adjusted average must be used if it is the highest for the season.
 - d. Bowlers with none of the above must bowl scratch (220 average).
 - e. If the 2023-2024 average for at least 21 games at the time of bowling exceeds **the 2022-2023 average by 10 pins or more**, the 2023-2024 average must be used (Rule 319a, item 2).
 - f. An entrant must report any average adjustment (re-rate) from another tournament, even if the entrant did not accept the adjusted average.
 - g. The Tournament Director reserves the right to go back three years if it is believed that the participant is presenting an average lower than his or her playing ability.
 - h. It shall be the responsibility of each bowler to verify the accuracy of his or her average, whether originally submitted by the bowler, his or her captain or others. Failure to use the proper average shall disqualify your scores if submitted average is lower than actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification or more handicap. Prize winnings shall be based on the submitted average if it is higher than the actual average (Handicap only).
6. Any protest or correction pertaining to the prize fund results must be received in writing within ten (10) days after the distribution of the tournament unofficial results.
7. The handicap shall be 80% of 220 scratch. Bowlers will certify their scores as being correct at the completion of each game. Handicap is figured on an individual basis.

E) Provisional ball or frame will be used in situation where a foul or legality of pin fall cannot be immediately resolved.

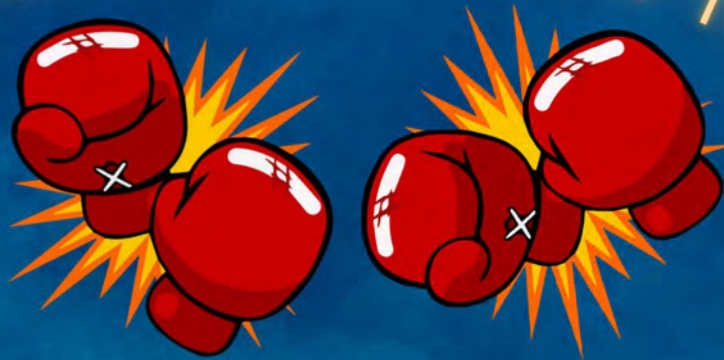
